

## **PITCH IN – CLEAN UP COMMITTEE MINUTES OCTOBER 4, 2011**

Debbie welcomed everyone and conducted the meeting. Tim Rasmussen was unable to attend due to another meeting.

The committee discussed the draft letter that he had emailed to members. The letter is for recognizing business improvements. Members approved the draft letter.

Becky said she would talk to Steve Christensen, Public Works Director, about storing flowers at the pool this winter. Debbie said she would try to speak with Steve this evening prior to council meeting. Debbie would let Becky know the outcome. Becky said if the pool were available the flowers would need to be dug up soon.

Becky mentioned she and Tim had picked up all Main Street Beautification signs and the Yard of the Month sign. All the signs are being stored at her residence.

Becky asked when would be a good day to decorate the welcome sign. The committee agreed on October 10<sup>th</sup> at 1 P.M. after a discussion. The committee also discussed when the flowers would be dug up if a storage area were available. The committee decided to do it on the same day. If the flowers were to be dug up, the committee would meet at 11 A.M. on October 10<sup>th</sup> at the welcome sign. Becky said she would pick up the hay bales prior to that day. Cowboy Up is donating the hay bales. Jack Whiting and Brad Finch are donating the pumpkins. Becky will borrow a plastic skeleton from Tim and will take the skeleton down after Halloween. The rest of the decorations will be left up as weather permits.

Debbie suggested asking the Boys and Girls Club children to help decorate the welcome sign for Christmas. Debbie suggested budgeting \$100.00 for decorations. The committee would like the welcome sign and the gazebo decorated before December 1<sup>st</sup>.

Becky mentioned one of the new trees on Main Street would need to be replaced. After speaking with Mayor Holaway, she was able to purchase 8 trees at Christopher's Garden. Two of the trees would be planted at the Boys and Girls Club on each side the their sign. Three trees are to be planted in front of the Post Office in the grassy area. Two trees are to be planted at the cemetery. Bruce said to make sure that the trees would not be on private property. Ron Welch and Dean Aronson would help with the location of the trees at the cemetery. She would like a locust tree placed in the Juniper Section and a pear tree

in the Spruce Section of the cemetery. Becky said she also purchased 3 bottles of Superthrive that will be reimbursed by the town for tree maintenance.

Debbie suggested adding Bryce and Sharon Burnham at 50 S. Aspen to the list of Yard of the Month nominees for next year.

The next meeting is scheduled for November 1<sup>st</sup> at 4 P.M. at town hall council chambers.
