

## **PITCH IN – CLEAN UP COMMITTEE MINUTES DECEMBER 15, 2011**

The committee members met at Mr. Ray Sholley's home. Some members introduced themselves to Mr. Sholley.

Mr. Sholley showed the members his design for the Centennial Park Sign. The sign impressed the members. The sign will weigh about 185 pounds when it is completed. Neil and Mr. Sholley discussed the mounting options. Mr. Sholley said any hardware would need to be treated at the same time that the sign is treated with acid wash. He would like to use Grade 8 2" bolts. The sign would be 58" on center with 2" OD tube steel posts for mounting. Town of Eagar personnel will mount it into a sleeve. The back panel will be 16 gauge.

There will be ceramic tile for the background of all cut outs. The back panel will be attached so the tile can be slid in from the top. Members agreed the state should have a copper color to it. The star will be welded to the border that will surround the drawing of the state. Joe suggested a pale green tile for behind the tree. There was a discussion on the maintenance required for the sign. Mr. Sholley suggested treating the completed sign with clear crystal coat of Krylon, annually.

After a discussion, it was agreed that Public Works would pick up the sign from Mr. Sholley's residence.

Mr. Sholley asked about a time frame for the sign's completion. Tim said that the Centennial Park celebration would be on July 3, 2012. The members would like to see the sign completed and in place by February 14, 2012 in time for the actual State Centennial celebration.

Mr. Sholley will keep in touch with Tim and Neil on the progress of the sign and let them know of any concerns.

Next regular meeting for the committee will be January 3, 2012 at 4 P.M. at town hall council chambers.
