



## Town of Eagar Snow Removal Policy

The Town of Eagar begins snow removal with a minimum of 2" of accumulation. Cinders may be applied with less than 2" of snow accumulation as needed.

Priorities are:

- Emergency vehicle response route. (Police, Fire and Ambulance)
- Primary Roads, (Main St and School Bus Rd.) Town owned public parking lots. (Central Ave. is plowed by ADOT)
- Secondary/Residential roads.
- Cindering as needed.

Please do not park in the town right-of-way during and after a snow storm. The snow plow operator needs room to do a good job.

Main St., between Central and 4<sup>th</sup> St can get very icy with little or no snow accumulation. During cold weather when it rains or snows please be cautious in this area. The road will be cindered when conditions are right. If there is just ice on the road cinders do little to help you from sliding on the ice.

Winter Driving tips:

- Decrease your speeds and leave yourself plenty of room to stop. You should allow at least three times more space than usual between your car and the car in front of you.
- Break gently to avoid skidding. If your wheels start to lock up, ease off the breaks.
- Turn on your lights to increase your visibility to other motorists.
- Keep your headlight and windshields free of snow and ice.
- Use LOW GEARS to keep traction, especially when descending hills.
- Don't use cruise control or over drive on icy roads.
- Don't pass snow plows and cinder trucks. The operator of those trucks have limited visibility and you are likely to find the roads in front of them worse than the roads behind them
- Don't assume your vehicle can handle all conditions. Even four-wheel and front-wheel drive vehicles can encounter trouble on winter roads.
