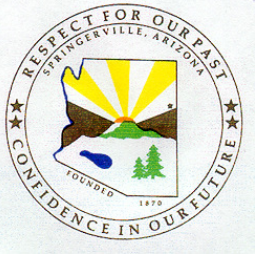


CLEAN UP DAY!



SATURDAY, MAY 20, 2017
8:00 a.m. till 4:30 p.m.

The Town of Eagar and Blue Hills Environmental Association are holding a free dump day at the Blue Hills Transfer Station and the Green Waste Pit. **Accepting up to one pickup load or 8 foot trailer load for free** at Blue Hills Transfer station. Additional loads will be charged at the regular rate. Free dumping of tree limbs or other green waste at the Green Waste Pit, but **please**, no dumping of rocks, metal or treated lumber. Make sure to bring your May water bill from the Town of Eagar or Springerville. If you are recycling, recyclables must be sorted into their categories listed below.

Household Hazardous Waste Collection at North Parking Lot at Bashas` - Paint, oils, spray cans, etc..see flyer.

Recycling List:

Cardboard - Empty and flattened boxes. Please remove and discard styrofoam, packing peanuts and plastic wrap before placing cardboard in recycling bin.

Paper - Paper is **not** accepted at this time.

Steel & Aluminum - Steel, tin & aluminum cans, empty and clean paint and dry aerosol cans. **Please, no cat food cans.**

Paperboard - Dry food boxes, i.e. cereal, cake mix, cracker, beer and soda carriers. Inner core of paper towel and toilet tissue rolls, clean pizza boxes, shoe and shirt boxes. No waxed paperboard like frozen food boxes, produce, milk & juice cartons or juice boxes.

Plastics - All rigid plastics #1 thru #7. These include all soda bottles, detergent, water, shampoo bottles, milk jugs, other plastic food containers & all lids (remove lids from bottles & place in bin separately). No plastic bags, plastic wrap or styrofoam.

Glass - Glass is **not** accepted at this time.

Electronic Waste Items Accepted - Computers Monitors, Key Boards Scanners, Printers Fax Machines, Phones, Cell Phones, Batteries.

Tires - 5 passenger/pickup tires allowed free per household. Semi or off road tires charged at normal fee.

Paint & other liquids - **Are not accepted.** However, both Blue Hills and the Town of Eagar's Public Works Department accept used oil. If you have used oil, you can also drop it off throughout the year during regular business hours (Mon-Thur) at 1162 S. Water Canyon Road.
