The Town of Eagar has an opening on its Utilities Board. This is a volunteer position and a good opportunity to serve your community.

For background, the Eagar Town Council has created the Utilities Board by ordinance as an independent entity; and vested it with operational and fiscal powers including those of management and funding. The Utilities Board is a public body created by the Council and given authority to manage the utility functions of the Town. Meets the first Monday of the month at noon as business allows. (Three-year terms.)
