The Eagar Police Department will be conducting testing for a Police Officer position on April 22, 2013. Certified police officers will receive preference. The testing will be conducted at 174 South Main Street, (*the Eagar Police Department*), and start at 9:00 am.

Requirements:

A High School diploma, 21 years old and you must meet the Arizona Peace Officer Standards and Training (AZ POST) criteria. For more information about AZPOST criteria go to;

Certified Police Officers are preferred but non-certified persons can compete in the testing process. (*Police Certification can be from ANY state but you must obtain Arizona Certification within thirty days of hire.*)

Salary:

Salary range is \$36,500.00 to \$41,900.00 (*Depending on police experience*)

Benefits:

A \$2,000.00 hiring bonus for certified officers (*contact Eagar P.D. for details*), Excellent health insurance (*Medical, Dental and Optical*), initial \$1,500 uniform reimbursement, 4-10 shift schedule, On-call pay, 10 paid holidays per year (*100 hours*), Sick Leave (*96 hours per year*), Vacation (*1st year-40 hours, 2nd year-80 hours, more as seniority increases*), Take-home patrol car program, Paid over-time and comp-time available, Arizona Public Safety Retirement, a wonderful community to live in and raise a family plus two million acres in the adjoining Apache-Sitgreaves National Forest.

Testing:

The testing on April 22, 2013 will be a written test, oral board, and physical agility testing. If you are successful the following will be scheduled at a later date; a background investigation, polygraph exam, psychological exam, drug screen and a medical exam.
