All applicants had significant ties to the community as being life-long or long-time residents. Marsha Gregory comes from a recent background of prosecution and defense attorney experience and was recently elected the Round Valley Justice of the Peace. Kenneth Martin has a law enforcement background and has served as a pro-tem judge for several years within Apache County. Roberta Reed has over 30 years experience working for the Round Valley Justice of the Peace, and Eagar and Springerville Magistrate courts. She has served as a pro-tem judge for several years and was appointed Round Valley Justice of the Peace, and Eagar and Springerville Magistrate Judge upon the passing of the former Justice of the Peace/Magistrate.
