their budgets. Now committees should go through their budgets and take out what they don't need and add what they need and those budgets will be integrated into the Town's budget.

Mr. Nau informed the committee members that the Town did not have a property tax to help fund the town. The Town is funded by local sales taxes, shared state revenues, and highway user revenue funds (that can only be used for roads and road repair), and utility fees. July 1<sup>st</sup> the town will find itself managing its cash and your committee might be told "You can't do it now but in six months your committee can do it."

Committees will meet in April to discuss your committee's budget. Parks and Recreation budgets have been located in Facilities and Fire Department budgets. Committees should look at what Grants are available, as finding revenue is a big problem for parks and rec.

Mr. Nau went over the description of rolls of the various committees. Committees are advisory to town council and take recommendations to the town council. The Town Council establishes whether the committee recommendations will become town policy or not.
