

## EAGAR DAZE LOGGING RODEO 2015 EVENT RULES

1. ALL COMPETITORS WILL DRAW FOR ORDER
2. CONTESTANTS ARE ONLY ALLOWED TO ENTER ONCE PER EVENT
3. 100% OF THE ENTRY FEES WILL BE PAID BACK FOR 1<sup>ST</sup>, 2<sup>ND</sup>, AND 3<sup>RD</sup> PLACE
4. POINTS WILL BE GIVEN IN EACH EVENT 10-1<sup>ST</sup>, 8-2<sup>ND</sup>, 6-3<sup>RD</sup>, 4-4<sup>TH</sup>, 2-5<sup>TH</sup>.
5. FOR ALL SPEED CUT EVENTS-WAFER MUST BE COMPLETELY CUT BEFORE IT HITS THE GROUND, SPLINTERS ON WAFER WILL INCUR A PENALTY.
6. ANY TIES FOR THE ALL-AROUND, WILL BE DECIDED BY AN AXE THROW.
7. CONTESTANTS IN **ALL SPEED CUT EVENTS** (EXCEPT THE WOMEN, WHO WILL START WITH SAWS IDLING ON THE GROUND UNDER ITS OWN POWER WITH NO HELP) WILL START WITH A NON-RUNNING SAW, ON THE GROUND, WITH BOTH HANDS ON THE CUT LOG. ON THE MARK, CONTESTANTS WILL PICK UP THE SAW AND MAKE TWO VERTICAL CUTS THROUGH THE LOG. (UP, DOWN OR DOWN, UP) WAFERS WILL NEED TO BE SOLID WITH NO CUTOUT AND THE ENTIRE EDGE INTACT. TIME WILL STOP WHEN THE BAR CLEARS THE WOOD. CONTESTANTS WILL BE GIVEN A 5-INCH AREA TO MAKE BOTH CUTS. NO PULLING WAFERS OFF THE LOG WITH HANDS.
8. LONG PANTS AND CLOSE-TOED SHOES MUST BE WORN DURING ANY CUTTING OR CHOPPING EVENT.
9. A HEAD JUDGE WILL BE DESIGNATED AT THE BEGINNING OF THE COMPETITION. THE HEAD JUDGE'S DECISIONS ARE FINAL!
10. OPEN MODIFIED DOES NOT RECEIVE POINTS TOWARD THE ALL-AROUND.
11. **A SAW CAN PLACE IN 2 POSITIONS ONLY – WHETHER THAT IS A CHAINSAW OR CROSSCUT.**
12. CONTESTANTS WILL ALL CUT ON AUDIENCE (BLEACHER) SIDE OF LOGS.
13. CHAINSAWS WILL HAVE A MINIMUM BAR LENGTH OF 20".
14. **REGULAR FUEL ONLY IN ALL RACES, EXCEPT OPEN-MODIFIED AND HOT-SAW. IF USE OF NON-REGULAR FUEL IS DISCOVERED IN THE RACES WHERE IT'S PROHIBITED, THE CONTESTANT WILL BE DISQUALIFIED.**

**AXE THROW** – CONTESTANTS WILL THROW A DOUBLE-BIT AXE (REQUIRED) FROM A DISTANCE OF 15 FEET FOR WOMEN, 20 FEET FOR MEN. EACH CONTESTANT WILL BE ALLOWED 4 THROWS, THE HIGHEST THREE SCORES WILL BE COUNTED. A BULL'S EYE SCORES 6 POINTS: THE NEXT RING OUT SCORES 4 POINTS: THE NEXT RING SCORES 2 POINTS, AND ANYTHING STICKING OUTSIDE THE LAST BLACK RING SCORES 1. BLACK RINGS ARE PART OF THE NEXT INNER CIRCLE. IF TWO TIES OCCUR BETWEEN TWO CONTESTANTS, THEN A COIN-TOSS WILL DECIDE THE WINNER.

**PLUG-CUT** (TIMED EVENT) – MEN WILL START WITH SAW TURNED-OFF AND ON THE GROUND, WOMEN CAN HAVE SAW STARTED AND ON THE GROUND IDLING WITH NO ASSISTANCE – ALL WILL START WITH HANDS ON THE LOG. ON THE MARK, CONTESTANTS WILL PROCEED TO MAKE THE 4-CUTS INTO THE LOG, ROUGHLY A SQUARE-SHAPE. CONTESTANT MAY REMOVE PLUG WITH TIP OF BAR OR WITH HANDS. TIME ENDS WHEN PLUG CLEARS THE LOG. THERE IS A 3-MINUTE TIME LIMIT.

**TWO-MAN CROSSCUT** (TIMED EVENT) – CONTESTANT WILL BE ALLOWED TO SET SAW APPROXIMATELY ONE INCH INTO LOG BEFORE STARTING. ON THE MARK, CONTESTANTS WILL PROCEED TO MAKE ONE CUT THROUGH THE LOG. TIME WILL STOP WHEN THE SAW CLEARS THE WOOD. WAFER MUST BE WHOLE WITH NO CUTOUTS AND THE ENTIRE EDGE INTACT. NO TOUCHING WAFER WITH HANDS.

**WOMEN'S HORIZONTAL BUCK-** (TIMED EVENT)-CONTESTANT STARTS WITH RUNNING SAW, (60 CC ENGINE) CONTESTANT CUTS TWO WAFERS, TIME STOPS WHEN THE BAR CLEARS THE WOOD.

**WOMEN'S STOCK SAW** (TIMED EVENT) –SAW AND CHAIN WILL BE PROVIDED. START WITH SAWS IDLING ON THE GROUND UNDER ITS OWN POWER WITH NO HELP AND BOTH HANDS ON THE CUT LOG. ON THE MARK, CONTESTANTS WILL PICK UP THE SAW AND MAKE TWO VERTICAL CUTS THROUGH THE LOG. (UP, DOWN OR DOWN, UP) WAFERS WILL NEED TO BE SOLID WITH NO CUTOUT AND THE ENTIRE EDGE INTACT. TIME WILL STOP WHEN BAR CLEARS THE WOOD. CONTESTANTS WILL BE GIVEN A 5-INCH AREA TO MAKE BOTH CUTS. NO PULLING WAFERS OFF THE LOG WITH HANDS.

**SMALL SPEED CUT** (TIMED EVENT) – SAW REQUIREMENTS:

- ENGINE UP TO 60CC
- BAR (MINIMUM 20") AND CHAIN TYPES WILL BE LEFT UP TO THE CONTESTANT
- MUST USE A REGULAR GAS/OIL MIXTURE
- HOLES IN MUFFLER AND AIR CLEANER ARE ALLOWED

MEN WILL START WITH SAW TURNED-OFF AND ON THE GROUND, WOMEN CAN HAVE SAW STARTED AND ON THE GROUND IDLING, WITH NO ASSISTANCE – ALL WILL START WITH HANDS ON THE LOG. ON THE MARK, THE CONTESTANT WILL MAKE TWO CUTS IN A 5" MARKED AREA. TIME STOPS WHEN THE SAW CLEARS THE WOOD.

**TREE FALLING, BUCKING AND TOPPING** (TIMED EVENT) – MEN WILL START WITH SAW TURNED-OFF AND ON THE GROUND, WOMEN CAN HAVE SAW STARTED AND ON THE GROUND IDLING WITH NO ASSISTANCE – ALL WILL START WITH HANDS ON THE LOG. ON THE MARK, CONTESTANTS WILL FALL TREE AND MUST USE A NOTCH. THE TREE MUST FALL WITHIN THE SPECIFIED 8' ALLEY, IF YOU HIT THE STAKE YOU GET A 5-SECOND BONUS (5-SECONDS REMOVED FROM YOUR TIME). THEN THE CONTESTANT MUST MAKE BUCKING CUT, THEN TOP THE TREE (WHETHER THE TOP BREAKS OFF OR NOT). THERE IS A 3-MINUTE TIME LIMIT.

**JILL AND JILL CROSS CUT** (TIMED EVENT) – TWO WOMAN PER TEAM. CONTESTANT WILL BE ALLOWED TO SET SAW APPROXIMATELY ONE INCH INTO LOG BEFORE STARTING. ON THE MARK, CONTESTANTS WILL PROCEED TO MAKE ONE CUT THROUGH THE LOG. TIME WILL STOP WHEN SAW CLEARS THE WOOD. WAFER MUST BE WHOLE WITH NO CUTOUTS AND THE ENTIRE EDGE INTACT. NO TOUCHING WAFER WITH HANDS.

**SPEED CHOPPING** (TIMED EVENT) – **ALL CONTESTANST MUST WEAR FOOT PROTECTION.** CONTESTANTS WILL CHOP THROUGH A PIECE OF WOOD NO MORE THAN 10” IN DIAMETER. TIME CLOCK WILL START ON MARK AND STOP WHEN LOG IS SEVERED IN TWO PIECES. FOOTRESTS MAY ALSO BE CUT AT THE END OF EACH PIECE OF WOOD.

**WOMEN’S SPEED CUT** (TIMED EVENT) –SAW REQUIREMENTS:

- UP TO 60CC
- BAR AND CHAIN TYPES WILL BE LEFT UP TO THE CONTESTANT
- MUST USE A REGULAR GAS/OIL MIXTURE
- HOLES IN MUFFLER AND AIR CLEANER ARE ALLOWED

MEN WILL START WITH SAW TURNED-OFF AND ON THE GROUND, WOMEN CAN HAVE SAW STARTED AND ON THE GROUND IDLING WITH NO ASSISTANCE – ALL WILL START WITH HANDS ON THE LOG. ON THE MARK, THE CONTESTANT WILL MAKE TWO CUTS IN A 5” MARKED AREA. TIME STOPS WHEN THE SAW CLEARS THE WOOD.

**MEN’S SINGLE CROSSCUT** (TIMED EVENT) – CONTESTANT WILL BE ALLOWED TO SET SAW APPROXIMATELY ONE INCH INTO LOG BEFORE STARTING. ON THE MARK, CONTESTANTS WILL PROCEED TO MAKE ONE CUT THROUGH THE LOG. TIME WILL STOP WHEN THE SAW CLEARS THE WOOD. WAFER MUST BE WHOLE WITH NO CUTOUTS AND THE ENTIRE EDGE INTACT. NO TOUCHING WAFER WITH HANDS.

**MEN’S STOCK SAW** (TIMED EVENT) –SAW AND CHAIN WILL BE PROVIDED. CONTESTANT WILL START WITH SAWS IDLING ON THE GROUND UNDER ITS OWN POWER WITH NO HELP AND BOTH HANDS ON THE CUT LOG. ON THE MARK, CONTESTANTS WILL PICK UP THE SAW AND MAKE TWO VERTICAL CUTS THROUGH THE LOG. (UP, DOWN OR DOWN, UP) WAFERS WILL NEED TO BE SOLID WITH NO CUTOUT AND THE ENTIRE EDGE IN TACT. TIME WILL STOP WHEN THE BAR CLEARS THE WOOD. CONTESTANTS WILL BE GIVEN A 5-INCH AREA TO MAKE BOTH CUTS. NO PULLING WAFERS OFF THE LOG WITH HANDS.

**WOMEN’S MEDLEY-** (TIMED EVENT)-CONTESTANT STARTS AT SAWING LOG WITH SAW RUNNING, (60 CC ENGINE) CUTS ONE WAFER, TURNS SAW OFF, PUTS IT DOWN, THEN RUNS TO A DESIGNATED LOG, TOUCHES LOG, THEN THROWS AXE AT TARGET. TIME STOPS WHEN AXE STICKS. THERE IS A TWO-MINUTE LIMIT.

**MEDIUM SPEED CUT** (TIMED EVENT) – SAW REQUIREMENTS:

- ENGINE UP TO 81 CC
- BAR (MINIMUM 20”) AND CHAIN TYPES WILL BE LEFT UP TO THE CONTESTANT
- MUST USE A REGULAR GAS/OIL MIXTURE
- HOLES IN MUFFLER AND AIR CLEANER ARE ALLOWED

MEN WILL START WITH SAW TURNED-OFF AND ON THE GROUND, WOMEN CAN HAVE SAW STARTED AND ON THE GROUND IDLING WITH NO ASSISTANCE – ALL WILL START WITH HANDS ON THE LOG. ON THE MARK, THE CONTESTANT WILL MAKE TWO CUTS IN A 5” MARKED AREA. TIME STOPS WHEN THE SAW CLEARS THE WOOD.

**JACK AND JILL CROSS CUT** (TIMED EVENT) – ONE MAN ONE WOMAN PER TEAM. CONTESTANT WILL BE ALLOWED TO SET SAW APPROXIMATELY ONE INCH INTO LOG BEFORE STARTING. ON THE MARK, CONTESTANTS WILL PROCEED TO MAKE ONE CUT THROUGH THE LOG. TIME WILL STOP WHEN THE SAW CLEARS THE WOOD. WAFER MUST BE WHOLE WITH NO CUTOUTS AND THE ENTIRE EDGE INTACT. NO TOUCHING WAFER WITH HANDS.

**LARGE SPEED CUT-**(TIMED EVENT)-SAW REQUIREMENTS:

- ENGINE SIZE 80-140 CC CHAIN SAWS
- BAR (MINIMUM 20”) AND CHAIN TYPES WILL BE LEFT UP TO THE CONTESTANT
- MUST USE A REGULAR GAS/OIL MIXTURE
- HOLES IN MUFFLER AND AIR CLEANER ARE ALLOWED

MEN WILL START WITH SAW TURNED-OFF AND ON THE GROUND, WOMEN CAN HAVE SAW STARTED AND ON THE GROUND IDLING WITH NO ASSISTANCE – ALL WILL START WITH HANDS ON THE LOG. ON THE MARK, THE CONTESTANT WILL MAKE TWO CUTS IN A 5” MARKED AREA. TIME STOPS WHEN THE SAW CLEARS THE WOOD.

**3-MAN RELAY** (TIMED EVENT) – MUST HAVE THREE PEOPLE ON A TEAM, NO CONTESTANT MAY BE ON MORE THAN 1 RELAY TEAM. 1<sup>ST</sup> PERSON DOES A SPEED CUT WITH A MEDIUM SIZE SAW, WHEN HIS WAFER HITS THE GROUND, HE MUST PUT HIS SAW DOWN AND TAP HIS NEXT TEAMMATE, WHO WILL BE DOING A ONE-PERSON CROSSCUT. WHEN HIS SAW CLEARS THE WOOD, HE TAPS THE NEXT TEAMMATE. THE LAST TEAMMATE MUST DO AN AX THROW. THE TIME WILL STOP WHEN HIS AX STICKS IN THE SCORING AREA.

**HOT SAWS-**(TIMED EVENT)- SAW REQUIREMENTS:

- MUST BE A PRODUCTION CHAIN SAW, BUT CAN BE MODIFIED
- ANY FUEL MAY BE USED

**OPEN/MODIFIED SPEED CUT (TIMED EVENT)-** SAW REQUIREMENTS:

- ANY SAW IS ALLOWED AS LONG AS THE COMPETITOR CAN CARRY IT INTO THE COMPETITION AREA BY THEMSELVES. THE SAW MUST BE A SINGLE-CYLINDER, PULL-START SAW.
- ANY FUEL MAY BE USED.

**TREE FELLING** – TOP 6 POINT GETTERS WILL BE ELIGIBLE TO FELL ONE TREE. CONTESTANTS WILL GO ONE AT A TIME. A STAKE WILL BE PLACED 20 FEET FROM THE BASE OF TREE. THE CONTESTANT CLOSEST TO THE STAKE, OR THE CONTESTANT WHO HITS THE STAKE CLOSEST TO THE MIDDLE OF THE TREE WINS. TOP 6 LOGGERS IN POINTS WILL DRAW FOR LOG.
