This Certificate is delivered by Landlord based on these facts:

- A. Bashas' Inc., an Arizona corporation ("Bashas"), and its affiliated companies have entered into a certain Asset Purchase Agreement dated as of September 24, 2021 (the "Purchase Agreement") pursuant to which Bashas and its affiliates are selling substantially all of its supermarket operations to the Chain Purchaser, which intends to continue to operate as a supermarket chain; and
- B. Bashas' operates the grocery store located at 150 N. Main, Eagar, AZ 85925 which such property is owned by Landlord (the "Premises"); and

ORDINANCE NO. 2021-09

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF EAGAR, ARIZONA, AMENDING THE CODE OF EAGAR, ARIZONA A NEW TOWN CODE CHAPTER RELATING TO THE REGULATION OF MAINTAINING TREES; ESTABLISHING A PURPOSE; SETTING FORTH DEFINITIONS; MAINTAINING TREES ON PUBLIC PROPERTY; PROHIBITING HARMING PUBLIC TREES; ESTABLISHING REGULATIONS FOR MAINTAING TREES; SETTING FORTH VIOLATIONS; AND PROVIDING FOR ENFORCEMENT AND PENALTIES.

WHEREAS, Tree City USA is one of the Arbor Day Foundation's oldest programs, dedicated to a helping cities and towns become greener and healthier through the planting of trees and creating green spaces;

WHEREAS, for nearly seven years, the Town of Eagar has been recognized by Tree City USA as one of its participating cities and the Town seeks to continue its participation in this program;

WHEREAS, the Town seeks to enhance the quality of life and the present and future health, safety, and welfare of all citizens, to enhance property values, and to ensure proper planting and care of trees on public property;

WHEREAS, the Town seeks to establish practices governing the planting and care of trees on public property, and make provisions for the emergency removal of trees on private property under certain conditions;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of Eagar, Arizona as follows:

Section I. PURPOSE.

The Code of Eagar, Arizona, is hereby amended by adding a new Chapter 8.02, <u>Maintaining Trees</u> to read as follows:

Sec. X-X-1 Purpose

Sec. X-X-2 Definitions

Sec. X-X-3 Authority and Power

Sec. X-X-4 Tree planting and care standards

Sec. X-X-5 Prohibition against harming public trees

Sec. X-X-6 Adjacent owner responsibility

Sec. X-X-7 Certain trees declared a nuisance

Sec. X-X-8 Violations and penalty

Sec. X-X-9 Appeals

Section 2. Definitions.

As used in this Article, the following words and phrases shall have the meanings indicated:

Damage – any injury to or destruction of a tree, including but not limited to: uprooting; severance of all or part the root system or main trunk; storage of material on or compaction of surrounding soil; a substantial change in the natural grade above a root system or around a trunk; surrounding the tree with impervious paving materials; or any trauma caused by accident or collision.

Nuisance – any tree, or limb thereof, that has an infectious disease or insect; is dead or dying; obstructs the view of traffic signs or the free passage of pedestrians or vehicles; or threatens public health, safety and welfare.

Parkway – the area along a public street between the curb and the sidewalk; or if there is no curb or sidewalk, the unpaved portion of the area between the street right-of- way line and the paved portion of the street or alley.

Public property – all grounds and rights-of-way (ROWs) owned or maintained by the Town.

Public tree – any tree or woody vegetation on town-owned or town-maintained property or rights-of-way.

Top or Topping – the non-standard practice of cutting back of limbs to stubs within a tree's crown to such a degree as to remove the normal canopy and disfigure the tree.

Section 3. Authority and power.

A. Delegation of authority and responsibility. The Town Manager and/or his designee, hereinafter referred to as the "Manager", shall have full authority and responsibility to plant, prune, maintain and remove trees and woody plants growing in or upon all municipal streets, rights-of-ways, town parks, and other public property. This shall include the removal of trees that may threaten electrical, telephone, gas, or any municipal water or sewer line, or any tree that is affected by fungus, insect, or other pest disease.

- B. Coordination among town departments. All town departments will coordinate as necessary with the Manager and will provide services as required to ensure compliance with this Ordinance as it relates to streets, alleys, rights-of-way, drainage, easements and other public properties not under direct jurisdiction of the Manager.
- C. Interference. No person shall hinder, prevent, delay, or interfere with the Manager or his agents while engaged in carrying out the execution or enforcement of this Ordinance.

Section 4. Tree planting and care standards.

- A. Standards. All planting and maintenance of public trees shall conform to the American National Standards Institute (ANSI) A-300 "Standards for Tree Care Operations" and shall follow all tree care Best Management Practices (BMPs) published by the International Society of Arboriculture.
- B. Requirements of franchise utility companies. The maintenance of public trees for utility clearance shall conform to all applicable utility industry standards.
- C. Tree species list. The Manager shall develop and maintain an official list of desirable tree species for planting on public property in two size classes: Ornamental (20 feet or less in height at maturity) and Shade (greater than 20 feet at maturity). Only trees from this approved list may be planted without written approval from the Manager.
- D. Planting distances. The Manager shall develop and maintain an official set of spacing requirements for the planting of trees on public property. No tree may be planted within the visibility triangle of a street intersection or within ten (10) feet of a fire hydrant.
- E. Planting trees under electric utility lines. Only trees listed as Ornamental trees on the official town tree species list may be planted under or within fifteen (15) lateral feet of any overhead utility wire.
- F. Protection of public trees during construction. Any person, firm, corporation, or town department performing construction near any public tree must employ appropriate measures to protect the tree, including, but not limited to, placing barriers around the tree to prevent damage.

Section 5. Prohibition against harming public trees.

- A. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to damage, remove, or cause the damage or removal of a tree on public property without written permission from the Manager.
- B. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to attach any cable, wire or signs or any other object to any street, park, or public tree.
- C. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to "top" any public tree. Trees severely damaged by storms or other causes, where best pruning practices are impractical may be exempted from this provision at the determination of the Manager.

Section 6. Adjacent owner responsibility.

- A. The owner of land adjacent to any town street or highway, when acting within the provisions of this Ordinance, may plant and maintain trees in the adjacent parkway area. Property owners are responsible for the reasonable and routine maintenance of trees and other landscaping in the adjacent parkway area.
- B. No property owner shall allow a tree, or other plant growing on his or her property or within the adjacent parkway to obstruct or interfere with pedestrians or the view of drivers, thereby creating a hazard. If an obstruction persists, the Manager shall notify the property owner to prune or remove the tree or plant. If the owner fails to comply with the notice, the Town may undertake the necessary work and charge the cost to the property owner.

Section 7. Certain trees declared a nuisance.

- A. Any tree, or limb thereof, on private property determined by the Manager to have contracted a lethal, communicable disease or insect; to be dead or dying; to obstruct the view of traffic signs or the free passage of pedestrians or vehicles; or that threatens public health, safety, and welfare is declared a nuisance and the Town may require its treatment or removal.
- B. Private property owners have the duty, at their own expense, to remove or treat nuisance trees on their property. The Town may remove such trees at the owner's expense if the owner does not comply with treatment and/or removal as specified by the Manager within the written notification period.

Section 8. Violations and penalty.

Any person, firm or corporation violating any provision of this Ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be subject to a fine not to exceed five hundred dollars (\$500.00) for each offense.

Section 9. Appeals.

All appeals to a violation shall be heard by Town Council.
